Problem Statements

High rates of underage drinking among high school and college youth are causing concern

Data: 2008 NJHS Survey past 30 day use 45.7%

EMT calls/transports for 2011 show 559 patients between ages 13-25 (19%)

2010 CIE College survey reports 66.4% underage students drank alcohol in past 30 days; 72.7% all age college students drank in past 30 days; 40.1% reported binge drinking in previous two weeks

32.3% of 18-25 year olds admitted for txt are for alcohol use (NJSAMS 2009)

10% increase in alcohol txt admissions for Mercer County residents under 25 yrs (2006-2011) NJSAMS
