# SERVICES PROVIDED

#### What are Services Provided?

Activities, events, etc., provided with the purpose being to give information, build skills or provide social support for individuals within the community.

#### **Services Provided Types**

### **Capacity**

events/activities designed to build the capacity of those in attendance to be able to do prevention work themselves. (train the trainer)

**Example:** Coalition provided a Responsible Beverage Server training to the managers and store owner of the local A & B Carryout, so they have the skills to train all new employees hired on how to properly check IDs.

#### **Preventative**

events/activities designed to provide the knowledge or skill to those in attendance. (most of time the attendees are the end-user of the skill)

Example: Coalition provided a Responsible Beverage Server training to all of the employees of the local A & B Carryout, so they have the skills to properly check IDs.

#### **Services Provided Tips**

- Services provided can include, trainings you provide others, presentations you give, tables at health and community fairs, compliance checks, drug drop boxes or take back events, and more.
- **Recording the Number Served:** This could be the number of people who attended your class or presentation, the number of people who came to your table, or the number of people who used your drop box. For compliance checks and sticker shock campaigns, this number will be the number of workers at the store and any customers you talked with about prevention while there.

Recording the Length of Service: The amount you enter here will be the length of time you provided to those attending your service.

# **Services Provided Examples**

- Providing Information The coalition gave a 30-minute informational presentation on prescription drug safety in the home, at the parent information night at the ABC High School.
- Enhance Skills- The coalition sponsored/held a LifeSkills training at the XYZ school district and reached 30 youth in 12 classes. Each training session lasted 30 minutes.
- **Provide Support** The coalition implemented a parents support group for parts who have children that have been caught using/abusing drugs or alcohol.
